FAISALABAD: There is a need to switch Pakistan textile industry over to high-tech textile industry to make it more competitive in the international market, said Korean Ambassador Jin-Wook Kim.

Addressing a ceremony to hand over the Pak-Korea Technical Textile Research Centre to the National Textile University here on Thursday, he said that the Korean government had granted a support of \$3 million in the form of equipment procurement for the project in addition to imparting manpower training to the NTU officials. The Korean envoy expressed confidence that the centre would give a positive impact in the whole textile industry. He said that establishment of the centre at the NTU was a timely and meaningful decision as its aims were to develop and promote technical textile in Pakistan. He said that the centre would conduct various research and experiments. NTU Rector Prof Dr Tanveer Hussain and others also spoke.
